### Why do we pay dues?

Every sorority pays Dues to help contribute to the organization's basic costs. It's a team effort. Dues go to stoles, cords, Retreat expenses, giveaways, holiday cards, and more.

### How much are dues?

Dues are divided into two tiers, \$60 or \$120 per semester, to be paid in January and August. More info below.

### What payment options are available?

We provide AfterPay through Square as a way to break up payments.

### How do we stack up?

Zeta Mu Phi is the cheapest sorority known, in the world!

Other sororities cost \$150-\$1,000 or more per semester. Our goal is to keep costs low, thereby assisting our members as much as possible, while still meeting our organizational objectives.

### Waiver

Members Interested in a waiver must apply during the allotted timeframe and will receive an approval or denial email before the Dues period opens.
