



Philanthropy Internship Requirements

Planning

Our intern will have a hand in creatively planning & designing philanthropy month, Project 2026 overall, and the 2026 event in Nebraska from start to finish: beginning in August 2026 and tentatively ending in June 2027. Positions are volunteer based for experience and come with unlimited letters of recommendation for future reference.

Meetings

Intern(s) are a part of a board sub-committee and attend the majority of committee meetings on the first Monday evening of each month to discuss what is coming up in the planning schedule, and to keep up with timeline of processing. This does count as an excused absence from chapter meetings and vary from five minutes to an hour.

Creativity

The chosen member will propose fresh and innovative ideas for implementation that coincides with effective fundraising strategies and techniques that meet annual goals and promote the philanthropic culture; as well as give back to survivors of human trafficking and/or domestic abuse. Our chosen candidate must be a creative and motivated self-starter.

Design

The member should be familiar with Canva, or willing to learn, in order to assist Apparel & Merchandise with designs for shirts, logo's, and beyond; as well as letters mailed to attendees, and beyond.

Confidentiality

Our intern's are bound by the confidentiality clause and are not permitted to disclose anything retained within their temp executive leadership with chapter members; and will sign paperwork pending formal approval of the position that is legally enforceable.

Attendance

Our chosen intern(s) will be required attend and assist with the execution of the Project 2026 philanthropy Drop-Off event in North Platte, NE. They will serve under the direction of the Event Coordinator & Executive Director, or VP in place of the ED. The Drop-Off event will take place December 10-13, 2026. Optional event's with further role opportunity include the 2027 Z Retreat and Leadership Conference in Asheville, NC during spring 2027.
