Square provides an AfterPay option to break up amount into payments, if needed.



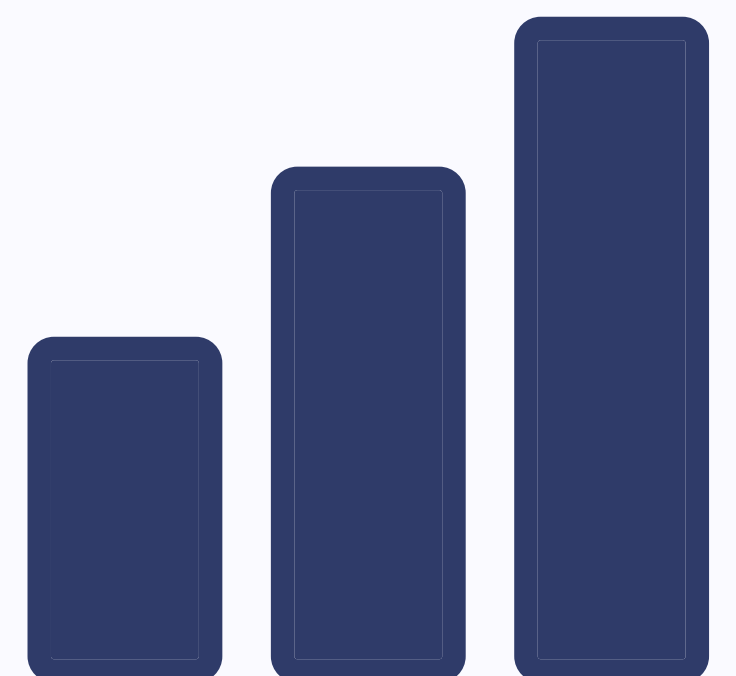
HOW MUCH ARE DUES?



Dues are divided into two tiers, \$40 or \$100 per semester, to be paid in January and August. More info below.

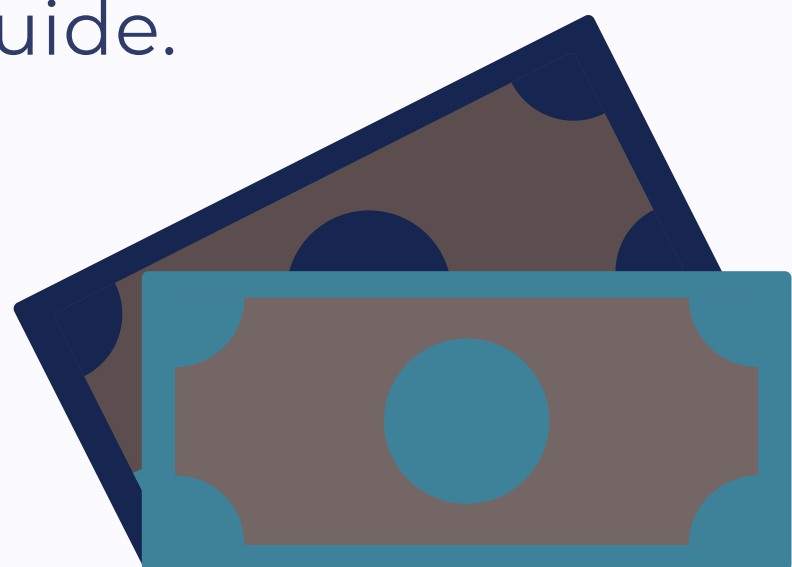




Dues Guide 2024-2025

TIER ONE: BASIC \$40

Includes: semester membership, cords (if requested by member during allotted timeframe), complimentary holiday card, and virtual sorority guide.



SPONSOR

You can sponsor a sister on our website, under Dues. The money will cover a sister in need.

WAIVER

Two waiver's per chapter will be awarded, if necessary, to sister's in need. Interested member's must apply in the allotted timeframe and will receive an approval or denial email before the Dues period opens.



WAIVER SELECTION



Member's that receive the waiver will remain anonymous and confidential. They will be notated as "paid" on the Dues form.

TIER TWO: ELITE \$100

Includes: Graduation stole, winter holiday card, birthday card, 24-hour Z Retreat presale, physical sorority guide, surprise gift once per year, welcome gift for members upon acceptance into the chapter.
